Holistic Health Awareness Program for Indigenous Women

Red Road HIV/AIDS Network (RRHAN) and Positive Women's Network (PWN) are pleased to announce that they have partnered to create a 2-year pilot project that will address the need for Indigenous women's HIV and hepatitis C prevention and support programming in Vancouver.

Holistic Health Awareness Program for Indigenous Women will provide a sacred place where Indigenous women can come together to share their culture in an Indigenous-led, women-centred, and women-only safe environment.

This program will be housed at PWN's drop-in centre, located at 614-1033 Davie Street, Vancouver, BC. An Indigenous Women's Service Worker will be hired to assist women with gaining knowledge and skills for improving and maintaining their health and wellbeing through an Indigenous lens. The program is scheduled to launch May 1, 2016.
