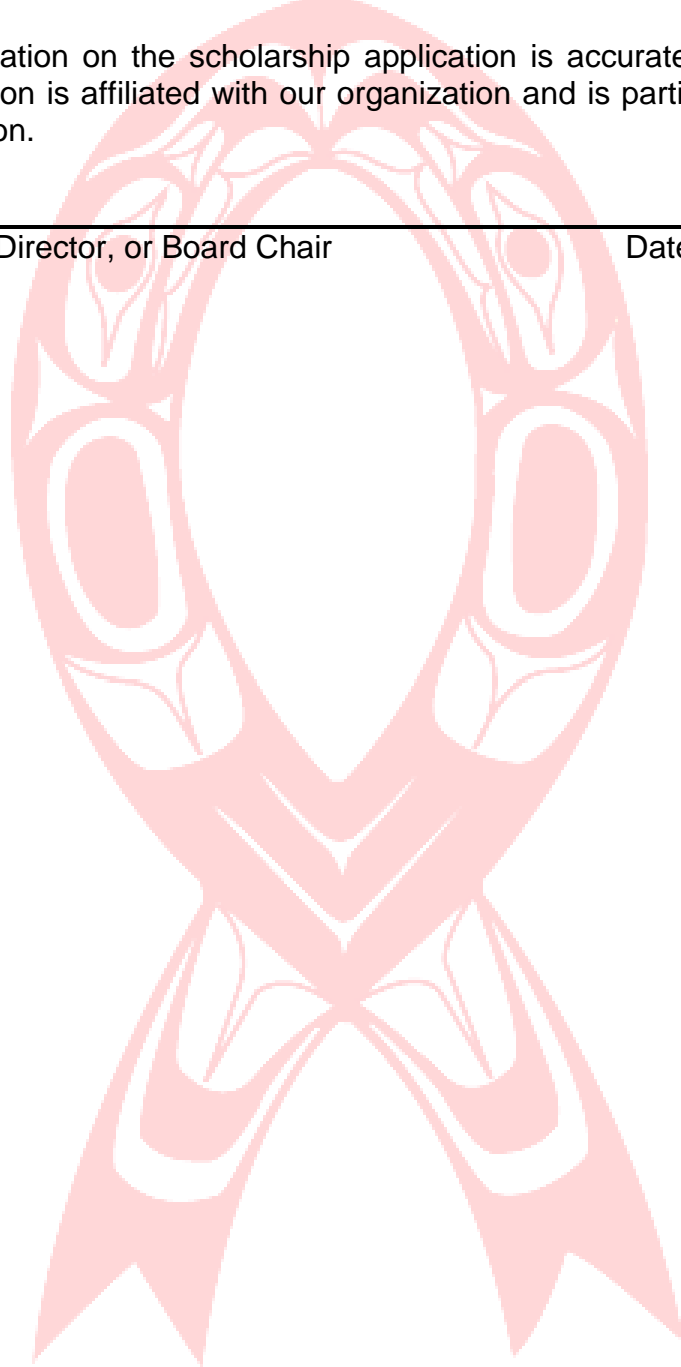

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCESS

The Skills Building Meeting will be held on September 19-20, 2016. PLEASE NOTE:

- 1.) The deadline for scholarship applications is Friday, September 9, 2016. The completed application form must be received (via mail, email or fax) by this date.
- 2.) Scholarships are only available to the Red Road HIV/AIDS members in good standing. **Also, applicants must be residing on Vancouver Island.**
- 3.) If an applicant is not an individual member of the Red Road HIV/AIDS Network, but is affiliated with an organization that is a member, a scholarship may only be provided if the applicant will represent that organization as its official delegate. The organization's Executive Director or Board Chair must sign the scholarship application form. Only one scholarship application form may be submitted by a member organization.
- 4.) As funds are limited, the Red Road is unlikely to grant any full scholarships, but will provide partial scholarships to cover the costs of travel, accommodation and/or per diem.

Travel scholarships will be provided only for your principal transportation (i.e.: bus, train, vehicle mileage) Additional travel expenses will be at the expense of the traveler. Recipients will be required to book their train or airline tickets through the Network's travel agent immediately after receiving notification of their scholarship award, so that the Network may benefit from the best travel rates possible. These tickets will be paid for directly by the Network and the traveler will be required to submit the ticket receipt or electronic ticket and boarding passes following the meeting. Bus tickets may be purchased by the traveler directly and reimbursed following the event by submitting the ticket receipt and a travel claim form, which they will receive.

Accommodation scholarships will be provided for a maximum of two (2) nights. Recipients will receive a cash advance for accommodation scholarship upon checking in/registration at the beginning of the meeting(s) upon presenting confirmation of their hotel reservation (fax, email, etc., from the hotel confirming reservation/stay). See note below. The traveler will be required to submit the hotel statement following the meeting.

- 5.) Scholarship awards will be made by a committee of the Red Road staff and the Board of Directors based on the following considerations:
  - The amount of the scholarship requested;
  - The number of application received and the funds available;
  - Whether the applicant is self-identified as person living with HIV/AIDS;

- Whether the applicant or the organization is a member of the Red Road;
- The work of the applicant or their organization with groups with specific needs and/or from underrepresented regions.
